

COARSE FISHING RULES

1. A St. Tinney Farm Fishing Permit must be purchased from Reception before these waters are fished by anyone. These permits are per person, per rod and cannot be transferred between people. A maximum of two rods per person are allowed per permit.
2. Please have your permit with you and ready for display at all times. They will be checked at the water's edge.
3. All those wishing to fish must also be in possession of a current Environment Agency Rod Licence which can be purchased online or at a post office. The Environment Agency do make regular on-site checks without notice and will impose a large fine on those fishing without a licence.
4. Please disinfect all fishing nets in the Net Dip provided, before fishing these waters.
5. No one under 14 years of age is allowed to fish without being accompanied by a responsible adult over 18 years of age.
6. All fish must be returned to the lake as soon as possible, with the minimum amount of time spent out of water.
7. A main line with a minimum of 4lbs rating must be used
8. Please use Barbless Hooks only.
9. Landing nets of larger than 30 cm diameter and a disgorger must be used.
10. No more than 1KG of bait to be used per day per angler (this includes trout pellets).
11. No imitation baits (eg fake corn) are to be used.
12. No Particle Baits are permitted except Sweet corn and Hemp which must have been purchased from a tackle shop. Boilies are allowed, but please only use in moderation.
13. Ground Baiting is permitted, but please only in moderation.
14. No fish must be kept in Landing Nets or Keep Nets, unless a match has been arranged by and is supervised by St. Tinney Farm staff.
15. Dawn to Dusk fishing ONLY (no night fishing) and all people must leave the lake areas at dusk.
16. No swimming is permitted in the lake.
17. Advance marking of pegs (by beach towels etc) is not permitted.
18. Please use designated pegs only.
19. Tackle left unattended at the lakeside for more than an hour will be removed.
